END OF SEASON REPLACEMENTS

We need your help in finding your replacement if you cannot work through Labor Day. We also have many pools that remain open through September and a few that stay open throughout the winter that need lifeguards.

Preference for the indoor, year-round pools will be given to guards that have been with us through the season, have shown up on-time consistently for their shift, kept their pools clean and orderly and who have been willing to fill in as needed.

FINAL CHECKS

For those of you who are leaving, please leave two or three self-addressed stamped envelopes with the address to which you want the check mailed, in the pool notebook. If you do not leave envelopes, these checks will be mailed to the address that is currently printed on your check. If you are an international student, you filled out a form at the beginning of the season as to where your last checks would be mailed and we have retained this on file. You do not need to do this again

SCHOOL HOURS

DC, MD Public Schools (all counties) and one VA Public School (Fauquier county) will be starting there school year prior to Labor Day (see below for specific dates - If your county does not appear in the list below, school does not reconvene until after Labor Day.)

Consequently, many of the pools in these areas will be resuming "school hours". Please check with your Supervisor as to whether your pool has school hours and what your new schedule will be (if applicable).

CHLORINE

Try and gauge final chlorine orders placed with the office. Pools which close on Labor Day should get their last fill based upon pool size. Please refer to your daily log sheet to determine the amount of chlorine on hand when you place your order. One inch equals approximately one gallon of liquid chlorine in the vat.

END OF SUMMER

Please remember that it is your performance these last few weeks that will be most heavily critiqued and can effect both your rate of pay and pool placement for the 2015 season. Keep in mind that we like to hire and promote from within. Good guards become pool managers, good pool managers can become supervisors!

Electronic Devices

When you are on duty, your primary concern is the safety of the patrons.

Therefore, the use of cell phones, ipads, tablets, computers, electronic games or any other electronic device is strictly prohibited when on deck or on duty.

Use of these devices, under any circumstances may be cause for dismissal

SMOKING

Smoking of any kind, cigarettes, ecigarettes or pipes, is not permitted on the pool deck or while on duty.

If you must take a smoke break it must be done off grounds when you are not on duty or on a meal break. Violation of this policy may be cause for dismissal
